

Instructions for patients after having chalazion excision.

- 1) If you have a patch keep it on for at least 4 hours.
- 2) When you remove the patch it is normal to see blood clots on it and in the eye. Your vision will also be blurry for up to a day because of the swelling and ointment used in the eye at the time of the procedure.
- 3) It is normal to have swelling and black and blue bruising of the eyelids.
- 4) After removing the patch apply ice cold compresses to the eye for at least 15 minutes every hour for the rest of the day.
- 5) Use Extra Strength Tylenol if you have pain.
- 6) Use drops as directed by the doctor.
